All e-transfers should include the club's name when sending the transfer. Entry fees are non-refundable.

Entries: Hy-Tek entries should be uploaded directly to REMS. Entry Deadline Friday April 3rd at midnight.

Meet Rules: SNC rules will govern the meet. [SNC Warm Up procedures](#) will be in effect.

Swim Wear: [SNC Swim Wear](#) rules in effect.

Starts will be conducted from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per World Aquatics II.16.1.4 and 4.1.

Swimmers may choose to start in the water or enter from a dive next to the blocks.

Shallow End Starts in-water starts will be conducted.

The Starter shall report a swimmer to the Referee for misconduct taking place at the start of a race as per Swimming Canada Part II 2.3.2. The "misconduct" shall include but is not limited to (C.2.3.2.1):

- Deliberate or negligent acts such as spitting, spouting of water, or blowing the nose in the

pool or on the pool deck immediately prior to the start may be considered misconduct.

- Deliberate kicking or striking of the starting platform, including the back plate prior to the start.
- Unsafe or uncontrolled entry into the pool immediately prior to the start of a race. During warm-up all swimmers must enter the pool with a controlled, feet-first entry.

Scratch Procedure: All scratches are to be submitted to the meet office. Please submit the swimmer's name, events, and club. No deck entries.

Officials: The names of the officials should be emailed directly to Sue Jackson. Officials must be fully registered with Swim Nova Scotia.

Warm-Ups: 30 minutes, sprint lanes will be open at Coaches discretion.

Safe Sport:

Swim NS believes that athletes, coaches, officials, support staff and volunteers have the right to participate in a safe and inclusive sport environment that is free of abuse, harassment, and discrimination. Details on Safe Sport during this event can be found here: [Swim NS Safe Sport](#)

Photography/Videography: In order to minimize risk, all photographs and video taken at Swimming Canada/Swim Nova Scotia sanctioned competitions, whether taken by a professional photographer or videographer, spectator, team support staff or any other participant, must observe generally accepted standards of decency. Under no circumstances are cameras or other recording devices allowed in the area immediately behind the starting blocks during practice or competition starts, or in locker rooms, bathrooms, or any other dressing area.
